

Uniform Policy

Purpose

A school uniform identifies children as belonging to a school, promotes school pride and acts as a means towards providing equality amongst children, regardless of socio- economic background.

Aims

- To provide security for children travelling to and from school.
- To encourage the wearing of school uniform as it enhances school spirit and pride.
- To avoid embarrassment and competition between individual students and their families.

Implementation

- A decision was made by the school community that school uniform should be worn.
- When change occurs in the school uniform, at least one year's notice must be given, to suppliers and interested parties of the impending change.
- Where students are attending official school functions or representing the school, wearing of school uniform is expected.
- Adherence to the standards of dress determined by the school community is expected.
- Students that are having trouble accessing a uniform can apply for student assistance through the AP Wellbeing.
- No student will be prevented from attending school or placed in a position of embarrassment because he or she is not wearing a school uniform.

Consistent principles

- Wearing of school hats is compulsory. Students that do not wear a hat will be asked to go to an area of the playground with full shelter.
- Jewellery and nail polish are not permitted.
- Students with pierced ears are required to wear simple sleepers or studs only.
- Students who tie their hair up/back should wear either green ribbons, the school check scrunchy (green and white checked) or green headband.

Students that do not have full school uniform including shoes on a particular day will have a uniform slip sent home stating the item of clothing that is not compliant. This slip will be sent to the family and will have to be returned to the school signed and dated.

SUMMER UNIFORM

GIRLS:

Check school dress with green tie at collar.

OR

Tailored shorts with lemon polo shirt with embroidered emblem.

Black leather school shoes with over the ankle white socks.

Bottle green school hat.





BOYS:

Lemon polo shirt with embroidered emblem with bottle green shorts.

Black leather school shoes with over the ankle white socks.

Bottle green school hat.



WINTER UNIFORM

GIRLS:

School wool blend pinafore with long-sleeved lemon blouse

OF

Bottle green gabardine trousers (or green shorts if preferred) with long or short sleeved lemon polo shirt with embroidered emblem.

Black leather school shoes with over the ankle white socks or green tights, School soft-shell jacket.





BOYS:

Bottle green gabardine trousers (or green shorts if preferred) with long or short sleeved lemon polo shirt with embroidered emblem.

Black leather school shoes with over the ankle white socks. School soft-shell jacket.

Bottle green school hat.



SPORTS UNIFORM (Unisex)

(To be worn on sports days only, unless explicitly stated for specific events, such as an excursion)

Green nylon sports shorts.

Sports shirt with embroidered emblem.

Sports shoes and white socks.

Trackpants and school jackets can be worn in Winter.





ADDITIONAL ITEMS

School Performing Arts jackets are only to be worn on Fridays or when representing the school at cultural activities.

Other representative jackets that do not have the school logo, are not permitted on days where school uniform is required (sports uniform or otherwise). This includes Sydney West sports jackets.

'MUFTI DAYS'

Special 'non-uniform' days may occur throughout the year, such as mufti-days, jersey day and pyjama day. On these days, students have flexibility with what they wear. However, students are still required to;

- Wear sun-safe clothing. Shoulders should always be covered (i.e. no singlets).
- Wear enclosed shoes.
- Refrain from wearing clothing with offensive images and/or slogans.
