Uniform Policy

Purpose: A school uniform identifies children belonging to a school, promotes school pride and acts as a means towards providing equality amongst children, regardless of socioeconomic background.

Aims:

- To provide security for children travelling to and from school
- To encourage the wearing of school uniform as it enhances school spirit and pride
- To avoid embarrassment and competition between individual students and their families

Implementation:

- A decision was made by the school community that school uniform should be worn
- When change occurs in the school uniform, at least one year's notice must be given to suppliers and interested parties of the impending change
- No student can be prevented from attending school or placed in a position of embarrassment because he or she is not wearing a school uniform.
- Where students are attending official school functions or representing the school, wearing of school uniform is expected
- Adherence to the standards of dress determined by the school community is expected
- Wearing of school hats is compulsory. Students that do not wear a hat will be asked to go to an area of the playground with full shelter
- Jewellery and nail polish are not permitted
- Sleepers and studs only allowed in pierced ears
- Students that are having trouble accessing a uniform can apply for students' assistance through their class teacher and Stage Supervisor.



The uniform consists of the following items:

SUMMER UNIFORM

GIRLS:

Check school dress with green tie at collar OR

Tailored shorts with lemon polo shirt with embroidered emblem

Black leather school shoes with over the ankle white socks Green only hair ribbons, school check scrunchy or green or brown headband Bottle green school hat

BOYS:

Lemon polo shirt with embroidered emblem Bottle green shorts Black leather school shoes with over the ankle white socks Bottle green school hat

WINTER UNIFORM:

GIRLS:

School wool blend pinafore OR bottle green gabardine trousers or green shorts if preferred

Long sleeved lemon blouse OR lemon long-sleeved polo

Bottle green pants with lemon polo shirt with embroidered emblem

Black leather school shoes with over the ankle white socks or green tights

School soft-shell jacket.

School hat.



BOYS:

Bottle green gabardine trousers or bottle green shorts if preferred

Lemon polo shirt with embroidered emblem OR long-sleeved lemon polo with embroidered emblem

Black leather school shoes with over the ankle white socks

School soft-shell jacket

School hat

SPORTS UNIFORM TO BE WORN ON SPORTS DAY ONLY

<u>SPORT</u>

Green nylon sports shorts

Sports shirt OR lemon polo shirt with embroidered emblem

Sports shoes and white socks

Trackpants and school jackets may be worn in Winter

Representative jackets (sport/dance/choir) are **only to be worn on Fridays** or when representing the school at sporting or cultural activities.

Students that do not have full school uniform including shoes on a particular day will have a uniform slip sent home stating the item of clothing that is not compliant. This slip will be sent to the family and will have to be returned to the school signed and dated.

If you have any further queries about uniform, please contact the school for clarification.

Evaluation: Regular evaluation should occur with the school community. Policy to be reviewed every year.
